# Business and human rights

## ISSUE

- Dutch companies do not comply with UNGPs and OECD Guidelines
- Dutch companies do not sufficiently perform human rights and environmental due diligence in their entire value chain

## IMPACT

- Human rights violations against local communities / indigenous peoples
- Pollution of air, soil and water
- Deforestation
- Land grabbing
- Loss of biodiversity

## RECOMMENDATION

- Implement, monitor and enforce Dutch mandatory human rights and environmental due diligence legislation at least in line with the UNGPs and the OECD Guidelines
- Design mandatory independent human rights and environmental impact assessments with the aim and responsibility for Dutch companies to respect human rights and the environment globally and make them part of the Dutch mandatory human rights and environmental due diligence legislation
