- Dutch companies operate in Global South
- No compliance with UNGPs
- No due diligence on human rights & environment and climate

- Human rights violations against local communities / indigenous peoples
- Pollution of air/ soil / water
- Deforestation
- Loss of biodiversity
- Land grabbing

Climate change and human rights

ISSUE

- Companies are not bound to the Paris Agreement
- Companies are not obligated to perform climate due diligence
- No binding emission reduction targets for companies

IMPACT

- Risk of dangerous climate change
- Risk of increase in temperature of more than 1,5 - 2 Celsius

RECOMMENDATION

- Ensure all public and private actors are legally obliged to set concrete climate plans of action to bring their activities in line with the Paris Agreement and specify criteria for corporate climate targets for carbon emission reductions in their entire value chain (scope 1, 2 and 3) in absolute percentages
- Ensure climate impact is part of the previously mentioned Dutch mandatory human rights and environmental due diligence legislation, the EU Directive Corporate Sustainability Due Diligence and the UN Binding Treaty for transnational companies and human rights
